
Subject: Common Traffic Advisory Frequency (CTAF) 120.25 Unreliable at Various Airort Ground Locations Wehen Albany FAA Contract Tower (FCT) is Scheduled Closed

Cancellation: 07/21/2015 1200 (UTC)

Pilots should be aware of possible unreliable ground communications on CTAF 120.25 when Albany FCT is scheduled closed. We have received several reports from pilots that broadcasted their intentions at opposite ends of either runway without receiving a response from other existing traffic. In all occurrences affected pilots advised their intentions and were unable to receive reliable communications from other existing aircraft.

The FAA and Albany-Dougherty Co. Aviation Commission are investigating a possible line-of-sight, or frequency interference problem. Pilots should continue to make normal self-announced broadcasts on CTAF 120.25 while conducting ground operations with emphasis on broadcasting at taxiway intersections near mid-field.
